

MODERNE LOG CABIN BLANKET

This lightweight blanket in a sophisticated wool/silk yarn proves that a $\log$ cabin can go to the Big City. There is no "center patch," and there are blocks of color instead of concentric strips. Drape it over a Barcelona chair, or your shoulders, and enjoy.
SIZE: 60 " x 50 " ( $50 \mathrm{~cm} \times 124 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) materials: Silky Wool by Elsebeth Lavold, [1.76 oz ( 50 g ) balls, each approx $192 \mathrm{yds}(\mathrm{I} 76 \mathrm{~m})$, wool/silk]
A: cream 4 balls
B: brown 5 balls

C: light purple 5 ball
D: dark purple 5 ball Size $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles
GAUGE: 22 sts +44 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in garter stitch.
Note: Throughout pattern, always pick up and bind off stitches on the RS.
block 1: Using A, CO 76 sts. Knit 66 garter ridges. BO.
block 2: Using B, pick up 66 sts from the row ends along the right selvedge of Block i. Note: Pick up one st from each
row end. Knit 33 garter ridges. BO block 3: Using C, pick up iog sts from row ends of Block 2 and bound-off edge of Block I. Knit 66 garter ridges. BO.
block 4: Using D, pick up 132 sts along bound-off edge of Block 2 and row ends of Block 3. Knit 66 garter ridges. BO.
block 5: Using B, pick up 175 sts along row ends of Block 4 and bound-off edge of Block 3. Knit 33 garter ridges. BO.
block 6: Using B, pick up 165 sts along bound-off edge of Block 4 and row ends of Block 5. Knit 33 garter ridges. BO
block 7: Using C, pick up 208 sts along row ends of Block 6 and boundoff edge of Block 5. Knit 66 garter ridges. BO.
block s: Using A, pick up 231 sts along cast-off edge of Block 6 and row ends of Block 7 . Knit 66 garter ridges. BO.
bLock 9: See diagram. This block creates two rectangles side by side. Use the intarsia technique of lifting one color over the other when changing colors, to avoid a hole where the colors change
Turn work so that the edge containing Blocks $\mathrm{I}, 2,4,6$, and 8 is at top, RS facing. Count 33 row ends of Block 4 and place marker at this center point of Block 4. You will be picking up along cast-on edge of Block I and row ends of Blocks 2, 4, 6, and 8. Using B, pick up 142 sts to marker. Join D and pick up I32 sts . Knit 99 garter ridges, lifting one color over the other when changing colors. BO.

## Border

Using D, make border as instructed on page 75 .

## Finishing

Sew in all ends on the back of the work. Lightly press with steam.

## MODERNE BABY BLANKET

This is a crib-sized, easy-care version of the Moderne Log Cabin Blanket, for the modern baby.

SIZE: $3^{\prime \prime} \times 28^{\prime \prime}(98 \mathrm{~cm} \mathrm{x} 70 \mathrm{~cm})$ materials: Calmer by Rowan Yarns,
 ( 160 m ), cotton/acrylic/microfiber] A: cream 3 balls
B: celery green 3 balls
C: sage green 3 balls
D: teal 3 balls
Size $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles
GAUGE: 21 sts +42 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in garter stitch.
Note: Throughout pattern, always pick up and bind off stitches on the RS block 1: Using A, CO 42 sts. Knit 36 garter ridges. BO .
bLock 2: Using B, pick up 36 sts from the row ends along the right selvedge of Block I. Note: Pick up one stitch from each row end. Knit 18 garter ridges. BO block 3: Using C, pick up 60 stitches from row ends of Block 2 and bound-off edge of Block I. Knit 36 garter ridges. BO

BLock 4: Using D, pick up 72 stitches along bound-off edge of Block 2 and row ends of Block 3 . Knit 36 garter ridges. BO. block 5: Using A, pick up 96 stitches sts row ends of Block 4 and bound-off edge of Block 3. Knit 18 garter ridges. BO. block 6: Using A, pick up 90 sts along bound-off edge of Block 4 and row ends of Block 5. K 18 garter ridges. BO
block 7: Using B, pick up II4 sts along row ends of Block 6 and bound-off edge of Block 5. Knit 36 garter ridges. BO. bLock 8: Using C, pick up 126 sts along bound-off edge of Block 6 and row end of Block 7. Knit 36 garter ridges. BO.
bLock 9: (Note: See diagram. This block creates two squares side by side. Use the
intarsia technique of lifting one color over the other when changing colors, to avoid a hole where the colors change.)

Turn work so that the edge containing Blocks 9, $\mathrm{I}, 3,5$, and 7 is at top, RS fac ing. Place marker between Block 3 and Block 7. Using D, pick up 54 sts along cast-on edge of Block 1 and row ends of Block 3, ending at the marker. Joining B, pick up 54 sts along row ends of Blocks 5 and 7 ( 108 sts). Keeping colors consistent, $\mathrm{K}_{54}$ garter ridges. BO
block 10: Turn work so that the edge containing Blocks I, 2, 4, 6 and 8 is at
op, RS facing. Place marker between Block 4 and Block 6. Using C, pick up I50 sts along row ends of Block 9 , cast-on edge of Block I , and row ends of Blocks 2 and 4 , ending at the marker. Joining D, pick up 54 sts along row ends f Blocks 6 and 8 . Keeping colors consistent, Knit 18 garter ridges. BO.

## Border

Using A, make border as instructed or page 75.

## Finishing

Sew in all ends on the back of the work. Lightly press with steam.
